

## **Downed Power Lines Safety**

## Assume all downed lines are energized and stay as far away as you can. Call 9-1-1

Energized lines can charge the ground near the point of contact and may electrocute you. If a person or pet comes into contact with a downed power line, remain clear. Do not touch them or the wire.



## Do not drive over downed power lines!

**Stay in your car.** If a power line falls on your vehicle while you're driving, do not exit until you know for sure that the line is de-energized.

If you must evacuate, jump away and land with both feet together. Do not touch the vehicle while stepping on the ground, as this can create a path for electricity to run through you.

**Shuffle away to safety.** Keep your feet together and take small, shuffling steps until you're at least 35 feet away. Taking larger steps can also create a path for electricity to run through you.
