## Bainbridge Island Fire Department Announces Open Houses Regarding Staffing and Facilities Special Election

The public is invited to attend one of five open houses to learn more about the February 10, 2015 Special Election which will include two propositions concerning the Bainbridge Island Fire Department. Proposition 1 would authorize the Department to increase its 2015 regular property tax levy to \$.95 per \$1,000.00 of assessed valuation for collection in 2016 for the purpose of hiring Firefighter/EMTs to improve service levels on the Island including staffing Fire Station 23.

Proposition 2 would authorize the Department to issue up to \$16 million in general obligation bonds for the purpose of paying costs associated with rebuilding, remodeling and equipping fire stations.
