Hiring Announcement – Emergency Vehicle Technician

THE POSITION

The Bainbridge Island Fire Department is seeking to fill the position of Emergency Vehicle Technician due to a planned, upcoming retirement. The position maintains a fleet of fire apparatus, emergency vehicles, and staff vehicles out of a dedicated, fully-equipped shop located in one of the fire stations. This is a full time, civilian position that works a flexible 40-hour per week schedule. Salary range of \$73,156.14 to \$91,445.18 annually for 2019 is based upon the current Collective Bargaining Agreement with IAFF Local 4034. The minimum qualifications for the position are listed in the approved job description that accompanies this hiring announcement.

THE DEPARTMENT

The Department provides fire suppression, BLS and ALS emergency medical services, and a variety of specialty services including technical rescue, marine firefighting and wildland response to the 24,000 residents of Bainbridge Island. The 40 full time personnel and 30 volunteers work from three stations to provide coverage to the 28 square miles of the district. In 2019 the BIFD responded to over 3,000 calls for service; 70% of the responses were for EMS. The fleet consists of four fire engines, five aid/medic units, one ladder truck, three tenders, and a variety of other support vehicles including a boat.
