#### THE ISLAND

Bainbridge Island is located in the Puget Sound, just a short ferry ride from downtown Seattle. It is the second largest city in Kitsap County with a population of just over 24,000 people, spread across 28 square miles. Bainbridge Island School District ranks 3rd in the entire State of Washington. There are also numerous recreational opportunities with over 53 miles of shoreline, over 1,500 acres of parks and open space with dozens of miles of trails for hiking, mountain biking and horseback riding. Amenities such as the Aquatics Center, Bloedel Reserve, Bainbridge Island Museum of Art, and the Bainbridge Island Japanese-American Exclusion Memorial provide many opportunities for residents and visitors to enjoy.

# THE DEPARTMENT

The Bainbridge Island Fire Department (BIFD) is a combination department, founded in 1942. BIFD is staffed by 40 paid, uniformed staff; 25 volunteers; and 6 administrative personnel. In 2018, the Department responded to over 3,200 calls for service. 70% of those calls were for emergency medical responses. BIFD operates out of three fire stations. The Department's headquarters fire station, Station 21, was re-opened in 2018 after being completely rebuilt. The south end Station 22, was also completely rebuilt, and re-opened in August 2019.

## THE POSITION

Salary range for the position is 64,646.40 - \$80,808.00 DOE. BIFD offers an excellent benefits package including medical and dental insurance, and the Washington State PERS retirement program. Generous HRA plan contributions are also provided. Several premiums are available including longevity for time with the Department and education if you possess a college degree.
