

Bainbridge Island Fire-Resistant Landscaping Guide

Selecting Appropriate Vegetation Near Structures



This list is intended as a guide for spaced plantings within the defensible space around your home. Fireresistant does not mean fireproof, so take care to plant in locations that can be pruned away from structures and consider further means of wildfire risk mitigation such as ignition-resistant building materials and healthy forest management.

Characteristics of fire-resistant plants

- Limited accumulation of dead material
- Sparse, loose growth habit
- Non-resinous (woody plants), thin sap
- Succulent-like leaves

Certain plants such as arborvitae, juniper, eucalyptus, spruce, true fir, etc. can increase the intensity, rate and spread of wildfire due to chemicals and resin present in the plant material and should be avoided near structures. Using native species when possible is preferred due to adapted characteristics, but diversity in the landscape is also important.
