## **Hiring Announcement – Fire Prevention Technician**

### **THE POSITION**

The Bainbridge Island Fire Department is seeking to immediately fill the position of Fire Prevention Technician. The position completes a wide range of work that supports community risk reduction through fire inspections, plan review, and fire investigations. This is a full time, uniformed, civilian position that works a flexible 40-hour per week schedule. Salary range of \$63,511.00-\$79,389.00/year plus excellent benefits for 2022 is based upon the current Collective Bargaining Agreement with IAFF Local 4034. The minimum qualifications for the position are listed in the approved job description that accompanies this hiring announcement.

### **THE DEPARTMENT**

The Department provides fire suppression, BLS and ALS emergency medical services, and a variety of specialty services including technical rescue, marine firefighting and wildland response to the 24,000 residents of Bainbridge Island. The 40 full time personnel and 20 volunteers work from three stations to provide coverage to the 28 square miles of the district. In 2021 the BIFD responded to nearly 3,000 calls for service; 70% of the responses were for EMS. Nearly 400 plans were reviewed as well as over 250 construction-related inspections conducted. Bainbridge Island also has over 1,000 occupancies that are subject to fire inspections.
